## The Master Gardener General Training Program

**C**alumet County Master Gardeners (MGs) are individuals who have an interest in horticulture and have taken Master Gardener training offered by UW-Extension. MGs share their time and knowledge with others. It is the acquisition of knowledge, the skill of gardening, and the giving back to the community that distinguishes UW-Extension MGs from other gardeners.

The Master Gardener General Training (Level 1) Program consists of 36 hours of in-depth training on a variety of horticultural topics. Classes are delivered using a combination of on-line learning and classroom instruction.

**To become a certified Master Gardener, you must:**

- Authorize a background check, Master Gardeners work with children through senior citizen age groups
- Complete the General Training Level 1 Course
- Achieve a 70% or better score on the final exam
- Complete 24 hours of volunteer service

Level 1 training runs for twelve weeks beginning September 27. Classes are scheduled from 6:00 pm until 8:00 pm.
