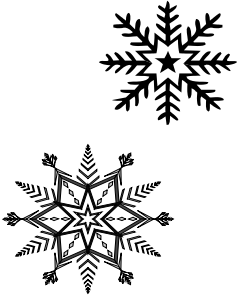


4-H Adult Leaders ... you are invited to a

Come join the fun!

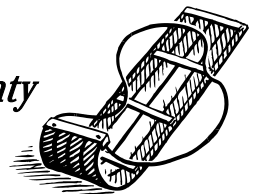
***Friday, February 8, 2019, starting at 7:00 p.m. thru
