






4-H WINTER LEADERSHIP CAMP

Camp cost: \$45.00 (The 4-H Leaders Council will cover half of the camp cost; therefore camp will only cost volunteers \$22.50.) Transportation is not provided.

4-H Winter Leadership Camp is a great opportunity for youth in grades 6-8 to improve their leadership skills. With hands-on, interactive leadership sessions, youth will gain a better understanding of what it means to be a leader and how to apply being a leader in their club, county, and school. Along with leadership learning, youth will have opportunities to participate in a variety of recreational activities that may include sledding/tubing, snowshoeing, crazy games, and other outdoor activities.
