



Livestock Project Boxes

Thank you to the support from the Calumet County 4-H Leaders Council in helping to coordinate and fund Project Boxes. 4-H engages youth in project-based education. Through project learning, youth can dive deeper into their interests and passions, ultimately mastering new skills. 4-H projects are meant to be hands-on to create a memorable learning experience. Project Boxes are an opportunity for hands-on learning. All of the boxes include either 4-H curriculum or instructions for self-directed learning. Some supplies will be included, and other supplies will be basic supplies found around the house or will need to be purchased. Some of the boxes will have some independent learning activities and some will include either a recording that youth may watch to help further their project learning and understanding.

For all of these boxes, youth will be required to submit a verification form to share what they learned in order to receive credit towards the Market Animal Sale.

- Compare and contrast the digestive systems of ruminant

Swine Project

- Learn about the varied uses of animal byproducts or coproducts
- Learn how to predict plant and animal offspring traits or characteristics using genetics
- Learn about different digestive systems, diets, what the nutrient groups are, how to read a feed tag and identify common livestock feedstuffs

Sheep & Goat Projects

- Learn about the varied uses of animal byproducts or coproducts
- Learn about sheep and goats and the various products derived from them

- Learn about different digestive systems, diets, what the nutrient groups are, how to read a feed tag and identify common livestock feedstuffs

Poultry

- Learn about the varied uses of animal byproducts or coproducts
- Learn about the effects of nutrition on broiler chicken growth and processing and simulate the mixing of poultry feed using animal feed rations
- Learn about different digestive systems, diets, what the nutrient groups are, how to read a feed tag and identify common livestock feedstuffs
