This exciting day has three main goals:

- 1. Help members, leaders, and parents learn something new—either by exploring a current project or trying out a brand-new one.
- 2. Encourage participants to share what they've learned with their club or project group.
- 3. Promote teamwork by having youth and adults work side by side.

It's a day full of discovery, collaboration, and the true spirit of 4-H!

Session 1 (9:00 - 9:50)

- 1A. **Bread in a Bag** Youth will learn kitchen safety and how to read a recipe by making bread in a bag. The bread in a bag will be for youth to take home to then bake!
- 1B. **Soda Bottle Rockets** Cloverbuds will be introduced to the rocketry project by learning how to make a simple paper rocket that we will then launch using soda bottles. Instructor: Carlea Liermann
- 1C. **Tie-Dye Drawstring Bag** Youth will get to learn how to tie-dye their own drawstring bag!
- 1D. **Perler Bead Bookmarks** Cloverbuds will love this easy project using pearler beads, popsicle sticks and glue to make their own bookmarks!
- 1E. **Pre-Shooting Sports: Rubberband Guns** Youth will get an introduction into the shooting sports project by learning the proper form and function of shooting rubber band guns.
- 1F. **Melted Crayon Ornaments** You'll make your own set of ornaments by melting crayons and mixing different colors together!

Session 2 (10:00 - 10:50)

- 2A. **Recipe in a Jar** Youth will learn how to read a recipe and measure dry ingredients, while making a recipe in a jar you can then gift to someone.
- 2B. **Perler Bead Ornaments** Make 3-4 different ornaments using perler beads. You could make a snowflake, a Christmas tree, a snow man, Santa, etc.
- 2C. **Woodworking: Firetruck** Cloverbuds will make their own fire truck complete with working wheels, a ladder and an attached fire hose!
- 2D. **Intro to Card Making** Do you want to brighten someone's day? Come make a few homemade cards that you can give to someone for their birthday, a special occasion or maybe just because!
- 2E. **Pre-Shooting Sports: Rubberband Guns** Youth will get an introduction into the shooting sports project by learning the proper form and function of shooting rubber band guns.

Session 3 (11:00 - 11:50)

- 3A. **Stuffed Animal Showmanship** Come and bring your favorite stuffed animal, and you learn a little bit more about the dog project by learning how to show off your own stuffie!
 - **Woodworking: Spy Scope** Youth will learn the basics of starting a simple woodworking project. They can build a spy scope periscope to see around corners without being spotted!
- 3B. **Pre-Shooting Sports: Rubberband Guns** Youth will get an introduction into the shooting sports project by learning the proper form and function of shooting rubber band guns.
- 3C. Fairy Garden Youth will learn how to make their own fairy garden using a terrarium dish, pebbles, animals, etc.
- 3D. **Edible Cookie Dough** Do you like licking the spoon? Then you'll want to make edible cookie dough! You will learn some basic kitchen safety while also learning how to read a recipe and how to measure ingredients
- 3E. **Set of 3 Ornaments** Cloverbuds will learn to make 3 different ornaments they can use to decorate their Christmas tree this holiday season!

Session 4 (1:00 - 1:50)

- 4A. **Stacked Bracelets** You will be creating up to 5 bracelets for each youth to mix and match or even share with friends!
- 4B. **Pie Crust** You will learn how to mix and roll out a basic pie crust, that you will get to take home with a variety of pie recipes you can make at home using the crust you make in this session.
- 4C. **Mini Tiered Shelf with a seasonal accent** Youth will make their own mini tiered shelf by putting mini crates together, and they'll be able to decorate it for all seasons and holidays. You'll even get to make your own seasonal accent to help get you started!
- 4D. **Woodworking: Candy Machine** Your kids can build a candy machine that really works! From the box to the front window to the release lever, your kids will be proud of this candy machine that's as fun to make as it is to use.
- 4E. **Intro to Air Rifle** Youth will be introduced to the shooting sports project. During this session they will learn safety rules, aiming, and hitting the target.
- 4F. **Fairy Garden** Youth will learn how to make their own fairy garden using a terrarium dish, pebbles, animals, etc.
- 4G. **Wooden HOME Sign** Youth will make their own HOME sign and paint different seasonal and holiday shapes change out on your wooden sign.
- 4H. **Intermediate Watercolor for Grades 6-8** Join us to expand your knowledge and skills in specific watercolor techniques. Participants will be guided through various painting techniques and complete one or more paintings.

Session 5 (2:00 - 2:50)

- 5A. **Fall Wooden Tic Tac Toe** Youth will put together their own tic tac toe game, while also painting or decorating their Fall themed pieces.
- 5B. **Decorated Cupcakes** This is a great intro for anyone wishing to learn how to use basic tips for decorating cupcakes!
- 5C. **Set of 3 Ornaments** You'll learn to make 3 different ornaments they can use to decorate their Christmas tree this holiday season!
- 5D. **Intro to Air Rifle** Youth will be introduced to the shooting sports project. During this session they will learn safety rules, aiming, and hitting the target.
- 5E. Intro to Leather Craft Did you know leather is a by-product of meat processing? The skin is preserved to become leather, and you will get to make your own creation. Come learn what leather craft is all about and learn how to use the tools to make your own leather craft pieces to take home!

- 5F. **Memo/Picture Boards** Brighten up your wall by making your own memo or photo boards! Each youth will get to make a set of 2.
- 5G. **Bow & Arrow with Velocity** Which arrow will travel the furthest down range when shot by the same person from the same bow? Youth will understand how velocity affects distance by assembling their own homemade bows and arrows and experimenting with them to see which ones travel the furthest.

Session 6 (3:00 - 3:50)

- 6A. **Wooden Snowman Hat Decor** By using a mini chalkboard, you'll make a decorative snowman hat to spruce up your space this holiday season!
- 6B. **Bow & Arrow with Velocity** Which arrow will travel the furthest down range when shot by the same person from the same bow? Youth will understand how velocity affects distance by assembling their own homemade bows and arrows and experimenting with them to see which ones travel the furthest.
- 6C. **Take & Bake Pizza** Youth will make their own 12" pizza to take home. During this session they will learn how to roll out a pizza crust and use toppings of their choice.
- 6D. **Air Rifle** Youth will be introduced to the shooting sports project. During this session they will learn safety rules, aiming, and hitting the target.
- 6E. **Decorative Sock Pumpkin** Did you know you can take an ordinary sock and make a super cute decorative pumpkin with it? Join us and you'll learn how to!
- 6F. **Candle Making** Have you ever wondered how do you make your own candle? In this session, each youth will learn to make their own, while personalizing it with different scents and other accents.
- 6G. **Hanging Shelf with Seasonal Accent** Do you like personalizing your room? You'll get to make your own hanging shelf that you'll paint and assemble yourself. You'll even get to make a seasonal accent to use with it!
