Cloverbud Session #1

Session #1 (9:00-9:50 a.m.)

Fabric Flowers -

Bring a bouquet of creativity to life by upcycling fabric scraps! In this fun, hands-on workshop, youth will learn how to turn colorful fabric into beautiful flowers that will never wilt. Participants will practice simple crafting techniques while creating their own unique blooms using a variety of fabrics, colors, and embellishments.

Sea Glass Wind Chimes -

Create a beautiful piece of art inspired by the colors of the sea! In this hands-on workshop, youth will design and assemble their own sea glass wind chime using colorful sea glass pieces and decorative accents. As they build, participants will learn basic crafting techniques and explore how wind chimes create soothing sounds when moved by the breeze.

Trail Mix -

Get ready to become a trail mix chef! In this hands-on cooking session, youth will learn important kitchen safety skills and basic food preparation techniques while creating their very own custom trail mix. Participants will practice measuring ingredients, following directions, and making healthy food choices as they build a snack that's perfect for their taste buds.

STEM Musical Instruments & Sound -

How do musical instruments make sound? Why do some notes sound high while others sound low? Join us for a fun hands-on STEM adventure as we explore the science of sound, vibrations, and pitch by building your own harmonica and guitar!

Sling-shot Cars -

Ready, set, launch! In this exciting hands-on STEM session, youth will design, build, and test their own foam-powered slingshot car. Participants will explore the science of energy, motion, force, and speed as they launch their cars and see how far they can travel.

Pumpkin Lantern -

Light up the Halloween season with a spooky and fun craft! In this hands-on workshop, youth will assemble their own glowing jack-o'-lantern lantern using colorful craft pieces and a battery-operated tealight candle. Once completed, participants will place their candle inside to bring their pumpkin creation to life with a festive Halloween glow.

Get ready to create a cozy scarf that's perfect for winter! In this fun, hands-on workshop, youth will learn how to cut, tie, and assemble a soft fleece scarf—no sewing required. Participants can choose colors and patterns to make a scarf that reflects their own style and creativity.

Treasure Keepsake Box -

Build a special place to store your treasures! In this hands-on woodworking session, youth will assemble their very own keepsake box using a Home Depot Kids Workshop kit. Participants will learn basic building skills as they put together a sturdy box that's perfect for keeping favorite mementos, small collections, special notes, and important trinkets safe.

Healthy Fruit Pizza -

Join us in the kitchen to create a colorful and delicious healthy fruit pizza! Youth will learn important kitchen safety skills and basic food preparation techniques while assembling a nutritious snack packed with fresh fruit. Participants will practice measuring, spreading, arranging toppings, and following a recipe as they design their own edible masterpiece.

Rockets -

3...2...1...Blast off! Join us for an exciting rocketry adventure as we explore the science of flight through hands-on STEM activities. Youth will build and launch their own rocket using a soda bottle launcher, then discover how air pressure and force can send rockets soaring into the sky.

Halloween Bracelets -

Get ready for some spooky-season fun as you design and create your very own Halloween charm bracelet! Youth will use colorful orange, purple, and yellow beads along with festive charms featuring jack-o'-lanterns, ghosts, and witch hats to make a one-of-a-kind accessory.

Woodworking - Birdfeeder -

Invite feathered friends to your backyard by building your own bird feeder! In this hands-on woodworking session, youth will assemble a pre-cut wooden bird feeder, learn basic building skills, and use sandpaper to smooth and prepare their project. Participants will also apply a protective sealant to help their feeder withstand the outdoor elements.

Rubberband Guns -

Interested in learning about shooting sports? This hands-on session is a great introduction for youth who are not yet old enough to participate in traditional shooting sports programs. Participants will learn important range safety rules, safe handling practices, and basic shooting sports concepts while using rubber band guns in a fun and age-appropriate setting.

Fairy Gardens -

Step into a world of imagination and creativity as you design your very own fairy garden! In this hands-on workshop, youth will learn how to create and arrange a miniature garden using a variety of plants, decorations, and fairy-themed accessories. All supplies are included, and participants will also have the opportunity to build some of their own unique accessories from scratch to make their garden truly one of a kind.

Flower Pot Turkeys & Windchimes -

Gobble, gobble! Celebrate the fall season by creating not one, but two fun turkey-themed crafts. In this hands-on workshop, youth will make a Turkey Flowerpot and a Turkey Windchime using colorful craft supplies, googly eyes, leaves, and other festive decorations. Participants will follow simple instructions while adding their own creative touches to make each project uniquely theirs.

Start your engines and get a head start on the 2027 Pinewood Derby race! This hands-on session is perfect for beginner racers and youth who may not have access to woodworking tools at home. Participants will receive a wedge-style pinewood derby car kit and learn the basics of designing, painting, and customizing their race car.

Protein Balls -

Get ready to make a delicious and healthy snack! In this hands-on cooking session, youth will learn basic kitchen safety skills while practicing measuring, mixing, and following a simple recipe. Participants will create their own protein balls and customize them with tasty ingredients like chocolate chips, peanut butter, M&M's, and more.

Propeller & Helicopters -

Have you ever wondered how things fly? In this exciting STEM session, youth will build and test two different flying experiments while exploring the science of aerodynamics. Participants will create a rubber band-powered helicopter and another flying design, then experiment with their creations to see how changes affect flight, distance, and performance.



Frequently Asked Questions:

Who Can Participate? Festival of Fun is for youth in grades 5K-8. 5K-2 is in the morning, and youth in 3rd-8th grade are in the afternoon.

I have two kids, and was wondering if I can sign them both up for the morning or afternoon? If you have children in different age groups, they do unfortunately have to sign up for the two different times of the day as sessions are designed specifically for their age group.

It tells me I am still a Cloverbud in 4Honline, what should I do? If you are registered before September 1st, and you're going into 3rd grade you can register as Cloverbud Graduate! Since we have not started our re-enrollment process yet, 4Honline still considers you a Cloverbud. All of our registrations are through 4Honline, where you can either do an online payment or send your payment of check or cash to Calumet County 4-H, 206 Court Street, Chilton, WI 53014. Once we receive your payment, we will approve your registration. You'll then receive a confirmation email that your registration was approved.

How do I know what sessions my child is in? Once you register, you'll know what session your child will be in. If it says there are 9 spots left, after you click that option you automatically claim a spot and it'll go down to 8 for the next youth registering.



Grades 3-8 Session #1:
